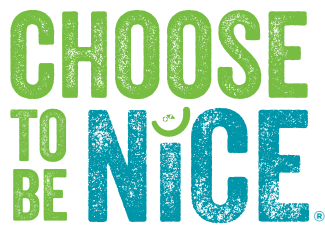

DISCUSSION QUESTION:

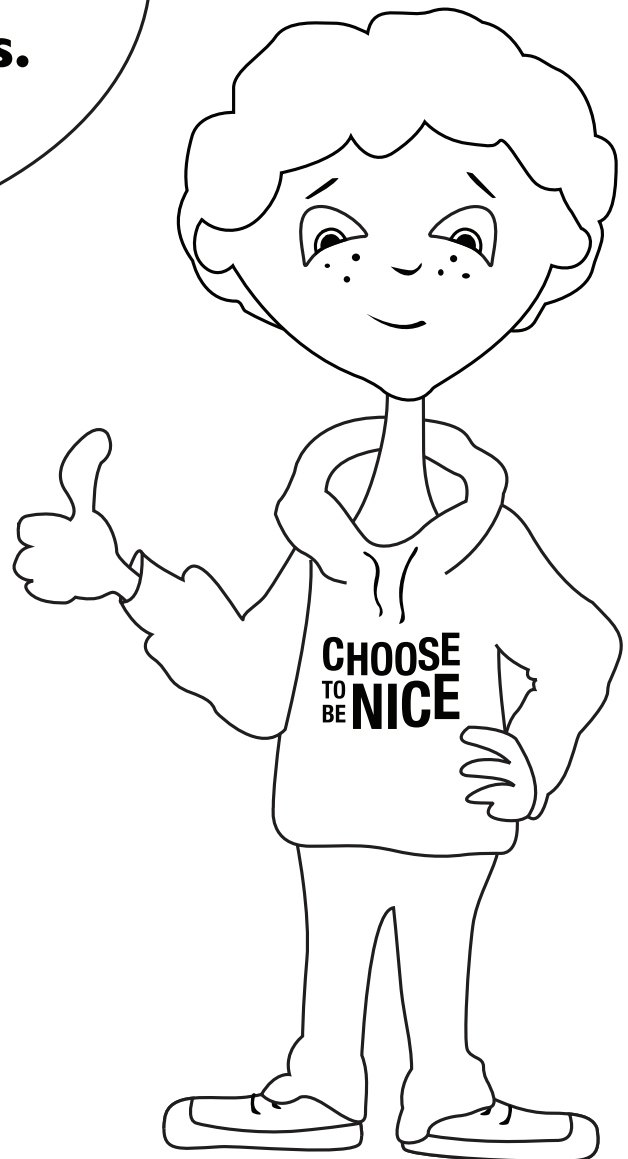
Why is it important to be accepting of others' differences?
