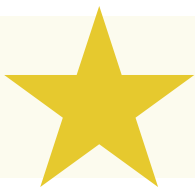
ACTIVITY:

DISCUSSION QUESTION:

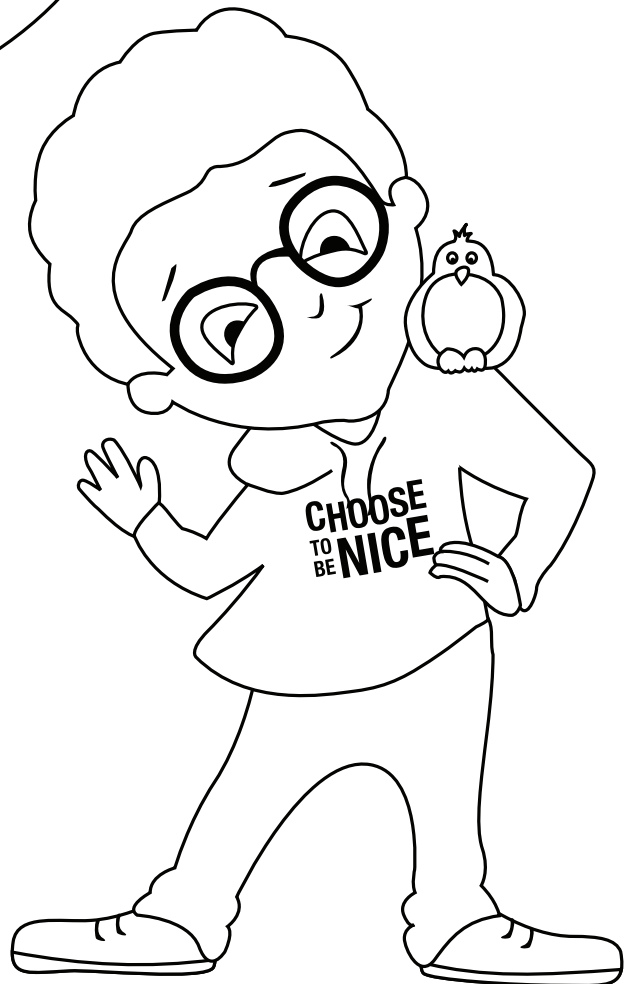
