DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

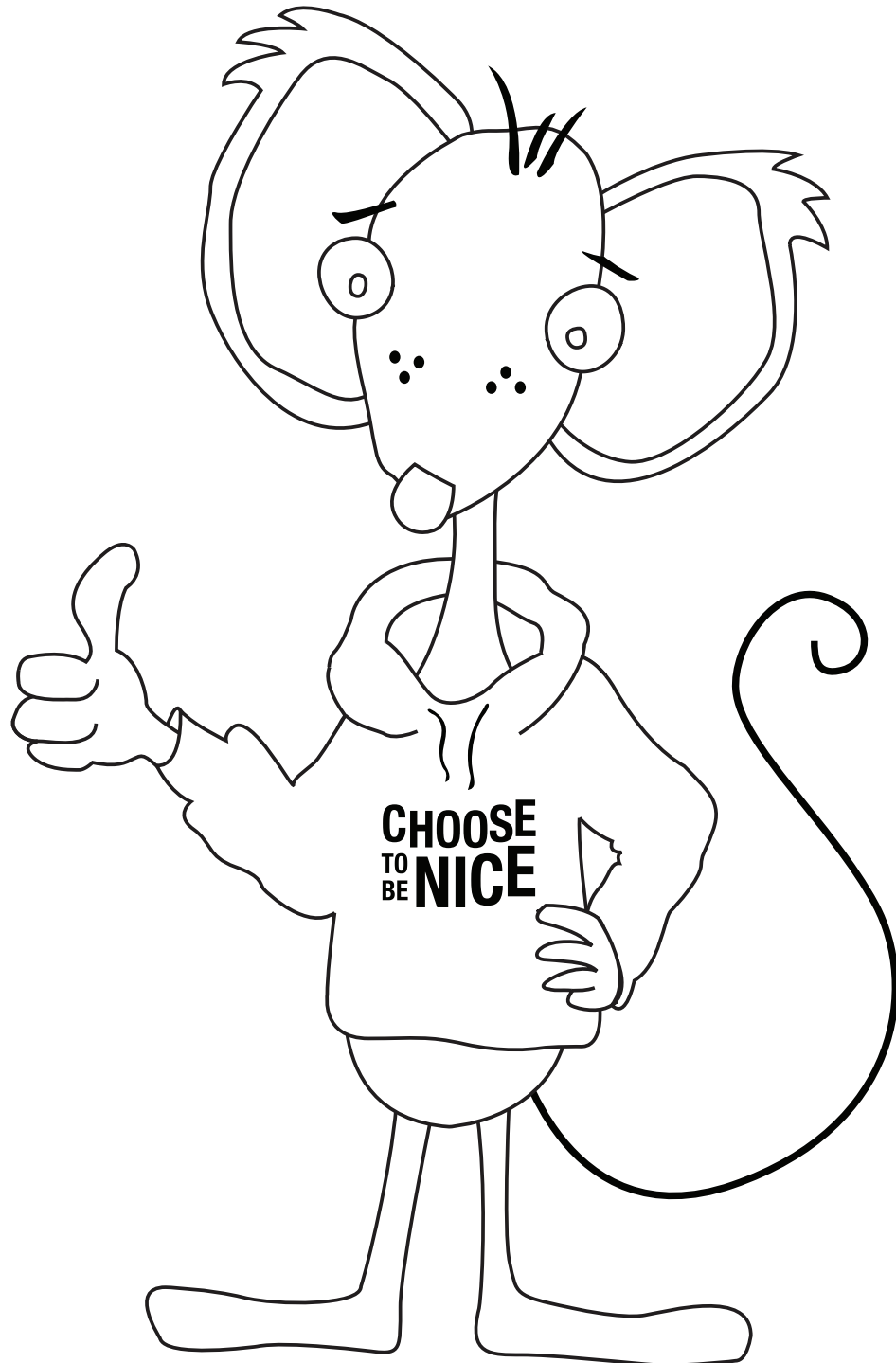
How are you similar to your family members?
