GRADES 3-5

The discussion questions have been selected to spark meaningful conversations and reinforce the Choose To Be Nice values at home.

RESPECT

- What does respect mean to you?
- How do you show respect to your classmates?
- How do you show respect to your family?

KINDNESS

- Have you ever intentionally excluded other kids from joining your group, game, or activity? If yes, why? How do you think it made them feel?
- Are there kids that you see being mean to other kids at school? If yes, what could you do to make them feel more valued and appreciated?
- What is the kindest thing anyone has ever said to you?

ACCEPTANCE

- Should you treat everyone the same? Why or why not?
- If you notice someone is not able to participate with the same ability as every one else, how can you help them?

TEAMWORK

- Is it better to work as a team or on your own?
- What makes a good team?
- What can you do to be a good teammate?

HONESTY

- Have you ever told a lie? What happened? How did you feel?
- How would you feel if someone lied to you?

- What are some examples of how you can be responsible for yourself, family, community, and world?
- What does responsibility at school look like?

FRIENDSHIP

- What qualities do you look for in a friend?

- What can you do to be more patient?

COURAGE

- What is something that you are afraid of? How can you confront your fear?
- Describe a time when you showed courage. How did it feel?
