-  Have your child illustrate or discuss three ways that they should always be honest at home. Ask your child to write a poem about being truthful, with each line starting with a letter from the word honesty.

-  Challenge your child to write a creative story with the title “Honesty Is The Best Policy.” The story may be fictional or based on a true scenario, but it needs to show how a character learned about honesty.
-  Share a time with your child when you told the truth, even when it was difficult. Invite your child to ask questions and share their own story of honesty.
-  Have your child write a story about a time when they had to tell the truth, even when it was hard. Then, share a time when you were faced with making a similar decision.
-  Discuss the importance of honesty with your child. Work together to create a “Fib Free Zone” sign to hang up at home.
