

ACTIVITIES FOR GRADES K-5



Talk with your child about what it means to be respectful and polite at home. Take a photo of your child showing respect to share with their teacher.



Have your child write letters or make cards to send to the local police or fire department to thank them for keeping them safe.



Have your child create a thank you card for their teacher or someone at their school. This card can thank them specifically for what he or she does.



Ask your child to write their own acrostic poem for RESPECT to define what respect means to them. When they are done, hang it up as a reminder of respect at home.



Together with your child, identify something that you can do at home to build respect for one another and the home environment. Then, have your child create a poster to hang up and act as a visual reminder.



Challenge your child to write a two-minute speech about the importance of respect. Have them practice their speech for different family members.
